

Yeshiva of Central Queens Behavior Code

I understand that at YCQ I am representing my family and Jews everywhere.

I will do my best to arrive at school on time, ready to grow and learn.

I must walk, not run, to help provide a safer learning environment.

I am responsible for my class work, homework and all books and materials.

I will treat my school, and the people in my school with respect.

I understand that my school has a dress code, and I am expected to follow it at all times.

I will use appropriate language and tone to settle my problems and differences. If this does not work, I will seek out an adult who will help me.

I know that if I own a cell phone, pager, or electronic device, it must remain off at all times I am in the school building. I understand that if I use it, it will be confiscated until my parents pick it up.

I know there will be a zero tolerance policy for any fighting, cursing, or disrespect to an adult.

I understand that I can never leave the classroom or the school without permission.

I understand that following the behavior code will allow me to continue on the path of a *ben* or *bat Torah*.

If I follow the behavior code, I will be part of a community that values religion, education and learning. I will be supported by my school; its principals, teachers, staff and fellow students. I will be able to succeed, and I will grow as a Jew, a student, and as a person.

I understand that not following the code will result in penalties ranging from denial of school privileges, detention, suspension, or expulsion from school.

JHS LATENESS POLICY: All Junior High School students are expected to arrive to class on time, prepared with all materials, and ready to learn. Any student who arrives late, will have the time noted and recorded in the school office. Once a student accrues forty-five late minutes, he/she will serve a detention period, AFTER SCHOOL, under a teacher's supervision. This policy will last the duration of the year.
